SUBJECT: Stage 5 Mandatory Water Conservation

Pursuant to Ordinance 1715 adopted by the City Council on March 12, 2013, as amended by Ordinance 1717 on March 26, 2013, and as amended by Ordinance 1726 on September 9, 2014 as codified in Section 17-220 F.c. of the City Code of Ordinances, this serves to certify that a failure of the raw water pipeline from Waurika Lake has occurred. Said failure has caused a great reduction in the ability to produce potable water by the Water Treatment Plant.

Further, in accordance with these Ordinances, this serves to certify that Stage 5 conditions exist based on the failure of the raw water transmission equipment.

In addition to the mandatory restrictions as laid out in the City Ordinance, please use discretion in indoor consumption of water to include but not limited to:

- Laundering of clothes
- Washing of dishes
